

Children's Trail and Woodland Walk

Come along, embrace the great outdoors and enjoy our award-winning gardens whilst exploring our Children's Trail and Woodland Walk.

It's with thanks to a contribution from the National Grid that we received funding for a project that has improved accessibility to our existing Children's Trail for people in wheelchairs, mobility scooters and families with pushchairs.

Our outdoor spaces are tended by an army of volunteers and gardeners who prune, plant, cut and mulch come rain or shine.

At Severn Hospice, we're proud of our strong community links and our easy access Children's Trail and Woodland Walk allow everyone the opportunity to be at one with nature, 365 days a year.

With access to free parking, you can take comfort in listening to the birds and the bees - you might also spot a pheasant or two.

You can access our toilets inside our Community Services Centre, whilst our café is open.



Dogs are welcome on-site but must be kept on a short lead – they may get a tasty treat in the café too if they're good.



Our grounds are a non-smoking zone.

Children's Trail

The Children's Trail is a short circular trail around famous fictional characters from a much-loved story. This trail is 124m and is accessible for people using wheelchairs, mobility scooters and families with pushchairs, and involves small inclines and declines along the way. Surrounded by pollinating plants, the trail has low-level wooden seating and can be accessed by two visitor car parks via tactile and block paving, and a gate.

Woodland Walk

The Woodland Walk is a short walk that encompasses different garden features including a storyteller tree, legacy sculpture and wooden bridge. The walk can be accessed via the two visitor car parks and from the café facilities located in the Community Services Centre. The bridge is accessible to all, with a slight decline at one end which leads on to an uneven, yet accessible pathway. There are plenty of benches along this route for visitors to use. This route is approximately 285m from the Refresh café car park.

Getting here

We're less than a mile from Bicton Heath Shopping Centre and Oxon Park & Ride, which can be accessed by exiting the A5 at Churncote Island.

From this direction, follow along the A458 and take the first exit at the roundabout towards Oxon Business Park and Clayton Way.

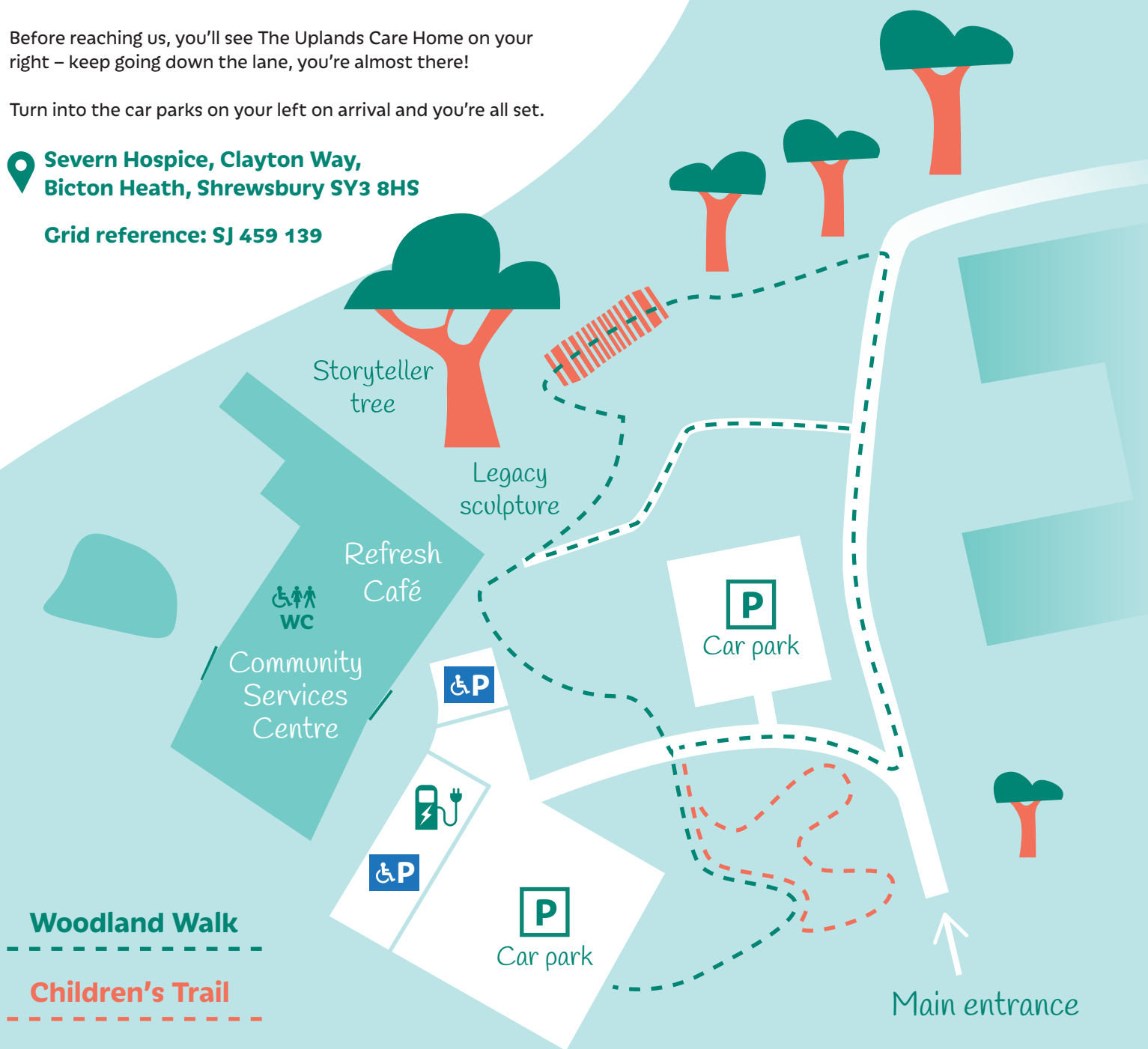
Before reaching us, you'll see The Uplands Care Home on your right – keep going down the lane, you're almost there!
