Transport

Parking: Open-air/surface car park. No parking charges.

Accessible Parking: No designated Blue Badge parking is provided.

Surface Type of Car Park: Combination of loose and compact gravel.

Train Stations: Nearest Train Station is in Shrewsbury (9.1 miles/14.7 kilometre)

Distance from Car Park to Viewpoint: Within 50 metre

Routes and Trails

Level routes/Trails: Circular walking route around the motte and double bailey.



Route Width: Narrow routes, some below 500 millimetre wide.

Ramped Routes: There are steep, uneven slopes around the site.

Gradient: Varying gradients.

Surface Type: Grass surface.

Rest Stops

Seating: Bench seating with backrests is provided either side of the motte.



Level Access to Seating: Uneven access to seating areas.

Distance between Seating Areas: Within 50 metre.

Interpretation

Interpretation Boards Available: Interpretation board includes some information on the accessibility of the site.

Accessible Height Interpretation Boards: Accessible height interpretation board is located on a grassy slope.



Pictorial Information: Motte and double bailey illustration is provided.

WC and Changing Facilities

General WC Provision: Nearest general WC facility is at The White Horse pub (100 metre).

Accessible WC Provision: There is no accessible WC provision.

Changing Places: The nearest Changing Places facility is Darwin Shopping Centre, Raven

Meadows, Shrewsbury SY1 1PL (7.68miles/12.3 kilometre).

Sensory Features

Touch: Plants across the site include knapweed (hardhead), shepherd's cress, thale cress, mouse-ear hawkweed and harebell.

See: A fine example of an early medieval motte and double bailey and surrounding countryside.

Smell: No particular smells.

Hear: Wildlife such as birds and bees in the spring and summer months, such as the whitethroat warbler.
